



Community Volunteer Opportunities

Movie Night at the Mission

Who: 4 - 8 volunteers

What: DVD movie usually 2 hours in length (must be approved by staff prior to showing)

When: Friday evening between 8:00-11:00PM

How often: Sign up for single evening or once a month

Other info: The Mission will provide DVD player and projection system. Groups will provide snacks (if you are unable to the Mission can).

Reception Desk

Who: If you are a shift worker, retiree or someone with an interest in providing a community service for the Rescue Mission

What: Answering phones and referring calls, greeting and assisting visitors to the office, and other projects as time and interest allow.

When: Monday through Friday 9:00-5:00PM

How often: Fill in our schedule as your schedule allows

Serving Food

Who: 10 - 12 volunteers

What: Serve meal trays; fill water, tea glasses to clients

When: Meal served at 6:30PM (invited to attend Chapel at 5:30PM)

How often: Sign up for single evening or once a month

Meal Clean-up

Who: 4-6 volunteers

What: Clear tables, help with kitchen clean-up

When: 7:00PM (meal served at 6:30PM you are invited to attend Chapel at 5:30PM)

How often: Sign up for single evening or once a month

Carpentry Program Instructor

Who: Are you a skilled carpenter in the building industry? Would you gain great satisfaction from passing your skills and knowledge on to others in a training environment?

What: This program will focus on giving basic skills in the building and construction industry to enable residents to secure employment in roles such as a builder's laborer.

When: Ongoing as needed

Maintenance Supervisor

Who: If you are a shift worker, retiree or someone with an interest in providing a community service for the Rescue Mission

What: This supervisor is responsible for minor maintenance and repairs of building, to include **basic** plumbing, carpentry, and painting. It is not expected that the person in this position will do all the physical labor required in this position; others will be able to assist as needed.

When: Ongoing as needed

Who: 12 - 15 volunteers

What: Wrap Christmas gifts donated to the Rescue Mission

When: Weeks prior to Christmas

How often: Time to be announced
