F. A. I. T. H. (Finding Alternatives In Treating Homelessness) Program Manager

The F.A.I.T.H Program Manager will be hired by and report to the Executive Director. He or she will be responsible for operation of the Fairbanks Rescue Mission's F.A.I.T.H Program. The F.A.I.T.H. program is innovative in its approach to the care and rehabilitation of homeless veterans because of its focus on sustained employment as the means to end homelessness. The program focuses on meaningful job placements to help with job retention and includes follow up efforts to ensure that those who find employment and housing have the resources they need to avoid returning to homelessness.

The ideal candidate will be an experienced leader and seasoned manager with a proven track record of personal integrity, effective communication skills, and a vision to improve the lives of the least, the last, and the lost of the Interior. The Program Manager will collaborate with the Executive Director and provide leadership to ensure that program quality systems and processes are implemented and monitored for effectiveness.

Qualifications:

- Bachelor's Degree in Social Work (BSW), Psychology, Counseling, Criminology or a related social/behavioral field
- Master's Degree in Social Work (MSW) provides distinct advantage
- 3-5 years experience managing social services with a nonprofit or other entity
- Excellent verbal, written and interpersonal communication skills
- Strong organizational skills are essential
- Must be able to prioritize work to keep several projects progressing simultaneously
- Make decisions involving significant discretion and judgment
- Experience working with people with addictive behaviors, mental illness, and/or co-occurring disorders
- Ability to work effectively with people of diverse educational and cultural backgrounds
- Experience in monitoring and fulfilling grant requirements
- Military service or experience is preferred

- Manage all aspects of the F.A.I.T.H. Program
- Supervise Case Managers
- Develop and cultivate organizational partnerships with government, private and nonprofit entities
- Monitor the quality of services offered
- Account for all funds associated with the program
