

The Mission operates the **only** overnight men, women and children's emergency shelter in Interior Alaska — and has a key role to play in the life of our Community.

Lives are changed at the Fairbanks Rescue Mission every day. These are men and women just like you and me, with families and children like ours. Somewhere, somehow, hard times came or bad decisions were made and they need a place to go for a helping hand.

Adult singles or families can stay at the Mission for up to 180 days. After the first 10 days (which are free), it costs 10 points a day. To earn points, residents do chores around the mission. Points can also be bought for \$1 per point. For the safety of our residents and staff we require all clients to be able to pass a breathalyzer test. We still do some Covid-19 testing.


